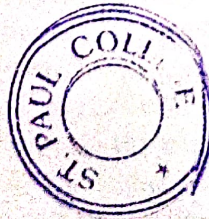

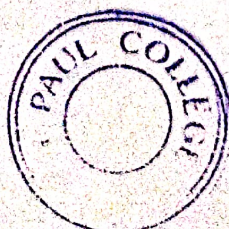
#### 2. Tree Plantation Drive

**5. Closing Remarks**



**6. Follow-Up Plans**



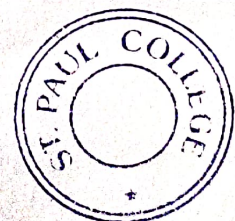
#### 2. Welcome Address

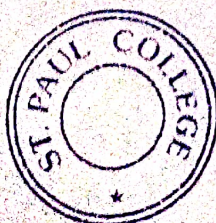
#### 2. Principal's Address

#### **Flag Hoisting Ceremony:**

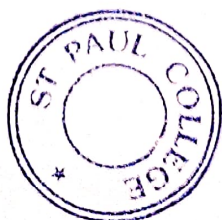

The event featured a series of cultural performances by students and faculty members, including patriotic songs, traditional dances, and skits depicting the





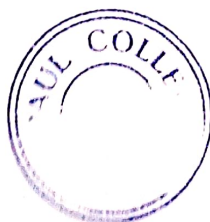
journey of India from independence to becoming a sovereign republic. These performances not only entertained but also conveyed important messages about the values and ideals that bind our diverse nation together.
